By 2028 we want to turn **most of our events into "Green Events"****! A commitment we have undertaken together with our international partners Maratona dles Dolomites and the Ski World Cup!



We aim to support a **sustainable mobility system** by raising general awareness and providing information to our guests. This makes public transport and **lifts** a practical and effective alternative – with great panoramic views. In addition, the bicycle is our number one choice for getting around the Dolomites in a sustainable way!



We are in the process of establishing **new travel periods**, such as spring and autumn, so as to offer our guests the opportunity to fully enjoy our territory while at the same time decreasing the number of visitors during the main travel periods.
